



Amphill Great Park

Parking address: Woburn Street, Amphill, Bedfordshire, MK45 2HX.

Note: Currently Google Maps refers to this as Woburn Road, as opposed to Street. Google is wrong.

Parking: There are two free car parks available, neither is well signposted from the street. You can see that there are entrances, but you wouldn't know what they were unless you were looking for Amphill Great Park. The car parks are not far apart (maybe a couple of hundred metres), so don't worry about which you park in. The Central car park probably gets busier if there are football or cricket matches on in the park. There is also parking available in Woburn Street.

Walk: There are several signs inside the park which illustrate trails that you can follow. Although the park is about 160 acres in total it's not one to get lost in, so walk where you want. If you know your way back to your car you will also be able to locate the cafe, which is near the Central car park and not very far from the West car park.

Food and drink: Amphill Great Park has a cafe which serves hot food and offers indoor and outdoor seating. If you don't want to eat in the cafe you could try the Chequers pub at:

Amphill Rd, Houghton Conquest, Bedford MK45 3JP.

It has a nice big outdoor seating area which is popular in summer, but generally you can find a seat. It also has a children's outdoor play area.
