

## Harrold-Odell Country Park

**Parking address:** Harrold-Odell Country Park, Carlton Road, Harrold, MK43 7DS.

**Parking:** There is a good amount of free parking at Harrold-Odell Country park. There is a car park as soon as you enter the park, and an overspill parking area at the end of a long sandy service road, which you may also park alongside. If all else fails on a very busy day you can park on Carlton Road Road immediately outside of the park.

**Walk:** The park extends to around 144 acres and includes river meadows by the River Great Ouse, lakes, and woodland.

The walk around the main lake, Grebe Lake, is around 1.6 miles. To walk the entire perimeter of the park would probably be closer to around 2.2 miles (guessing). There are maps on display to assist you.

There is a cafe in the park, as well as exercise machines and a small skatepark - so remember to take your skateboard with you.

The park is well tended, and has a 'friends of' volunteer force that keep the place looking good.

We were especially impressed by the number of seats and benches in the park that abound along the pathways. You won't go short of somewhere to sit on your travels around the lakes.

**Food and drink:** The Dragonfly cafe inside the park serves hot and cold food.
