Woodland owned by the Forestry Commission

Parking address: Sandy Lane, off the A600, about halfway between Chicksands and Deadman's Cross, Bedfordshire. No postcode. Alternative parking, intended for mountain bikers, in Northwood End Road, MK45 3QD.

Parking: Free parking in a designated area in the wood (See pictures). Be careful in the winter as gates are locked at 16:00 - though there is still a small area for parking outside of the gates.



The parking area straight ahead as you enter gets locked early in winter (middle picture). The small area below the steel frame (right-hand picture), does not get locked.

Walk: Just go where you like. There are lots of earthy paths through the woods, plus the woods extend to both sides of Sandy Lane. The second part of the woods lies between Sandy Lane and Northwood End Road. There are mountain bike trails on the Northwood End Road side.

There's plenty to explore. The woods are not so large that you are likely to get lost in them. You could probably walk the perimeter of the whole of the forested area in an hour - though that's a guess.

Food and drink: Nothing obviously near that we are aware of, though there is generally a burger van in Northwood End Road for the bikers.
